

AFA NORTHERN UTAH CHAPTER HILL AFB JUNIOR ENLISTED SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Objective

The AFA Northern Utah Chapter Junior Enlisted scholarship provides a minimum of \$250 to highly qualified E-1 to E-4 enlisted members (active duty, reserve or national guard) serving with Hill AFB or Utah units who have completed one year of college/university level academics.

Eligibility And Selection Criteria

- The complete application package must be received by 31 July 2017 to be considered.
 - The applicant must be an active duty, reserve or Utah national guard Air Force member of rank E-1 to E-4 within Utah of good standing and be actively enrolled in part-time or full time academics.
 - Have completed one year of college/university undergraduate level academics.
 - A minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent). Submit an official, original transcript of most recent college/university term.
 - Completed application form.
 - One letter from your supervisor or commander, which includes a character reference and description of performance.
 - Submit one written essay addressing the following topic. The essay must be 500 words, typed, double spaced and have the applicant's name in the upper right hand corner of each page.
 - Tell us about your course of study and what motivated you to choose that course of study?

Scholarship Allocation

- A check for the amount of \$250 (or more) will be presented in mid-August.
- The scholarship may be used to pay for reasonable costs in the pursuit of a degree. Reasonable costs include tuition, fees, and books.
- This scholarship is nonrenewable. Prior recipients are not eligible.
- Incomplete application packages will not be considered.
